#### **CONTENT SYNOPSIS**

This course surveys the history of professionals related to healthcare. The aim is to explore major discoveries, inventions and advances related to health in which these professionals have contributed to from past till present. The course will be taught through lectures, tutorials and workshop to highlight the contributions of some prominent Malaysian health professionals. Explanations and episodes will be compared and contrasted with Malaysian practices. Students will approach this course through critical interpretation, and informational presentations. The students will be evaluated via presentation, written assignment and end-of-semester. Upon completing this course, students will learn that the history of health professionals needs to be examined in order to integrate change in the future.

- 2. apply critical analysis on healthcare issues
